1	Master of Business Administration <b>(Natural Resource Management) *</b> <b>Duration:2 years</b>	Be a holder of a Bachelor's degree with a First Class Honours or a strong Second Class Honours (Upper Division) in any discipline such as Geology, Mining / mineral processing Engineering, Geography, Environmental Studies, Resource Management or related disciplines.
2	Master of Science in Mining Engineering* <b>Duration:2 years</b>	Be a holder of a Bachelor's degree with a First Class Honours or a strong Second Class Honours (Upper Division) in Mining and Mineral Processing Engineering; Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Geomatic Engineering, or any related Earth Sciences from Taita Taveta University or any other university or institution recognized by the University Senate, <b>OR</b>

\* Please note that only these Programmes/ study fields are eligible for scholarships as stated in the DAAD Letter of Offer

#### **Duration and Commencement**

These Master's degree scholarships are available for a maximum of TWO (2) YEARS. The scholarships will initially be granted for ONE (1) YEAR and may be extended upon individual request and receipt of a complete application made on the provided form.

Female candidates and candidates from less privileged regions or groups as well as candidates with disabilities are especially encouraged to apply.
